COLEMAN BOULEVARD

CURRENT STATUS FACT SHEET (9.21.17)



The Coleman Boulevard Improvement Project is an important infrastructure project for the Town of Mount Pleasant. Between the increased stormwater and waterline capacities and the mobility improvements, this project represents a true investment in the Town's future.

Details and FAQs

This key infrastructure project involves reconstructing Coleman Boulevard, a state-owned road, between Mill Street and Pherigo Street to create stormwater and utility upgrades. An adaptive signal system will be installed along Coleman Boulevard's entirety to streamline the flow of traffic. Additionally, the project will provide increased travel opportunities for bicycles and pedestrians, street lighting, a wayfinding system, a landscaped median, on-street parking and a vibrant activity zone between the roadway and buildings fronting the street.

Mount Pleasant Waterworks and SC DOT are project partners.

Highlights include:

- Improved drainage and water quality through expanded infrastructure and stormwater treatment devices
- Adaptive traffic signals and raised landscaped medians to help improve traffic flow
- On street parking and bike lanes are used to help create a traffic calming effect to make the area more attractive to pedestrians, motorists, bicycles and businesses.

What is the timeline of this project?

Construction is expected to begin in September 2017 and is estimated to be completed by August 2019.
